Uniform Reminder

In recent weeks it has become apparent that children are not always coming into school wearing the correct uniform.

Some reminders:

- Children should only be wearing their PE kits (inc red hoodies) on days that they have sport.

Connected curriculum -Term 5&6

Through terms 5 and 6 our curriculum focus across years 1-6 is **Sustainable Environmental Development.** Find out more on the phase <u>website page</u> and via Dojo.

KS1 (Apple, Cherry and Pear) will be exploring the big question: 'How can I help the environment?' They will see what a brilliant material plastic is but will think about the impact it is having on the world's oceans. They will look at how Yate has changed and how we can make sure we think of sustainability as we plan for the future.

Y3/4 (Sycamore, Ash, Beech) will be learning about volcanos, mountains and about how indigenous communities have lived sustainably within these environments. This will lead to a more indepth study of Ancient Egypt. Throughout their studies they will return to their key question: 'How can we make our environment more sustainable?'

Y5/6 will explore the question: 'Should development cost the earth?' They will look at the impact of development on natural environments.
