We are still working hard to reach our fundraising target of £10,000 to purchase a high rise climbing frame for all the children to enjoy. 85% of all income from the Friends fundraising events this year will go towards this target with the other 15% going towards smaller projects around the school. To date we have raised: GOAL £3,000 Christmas Fair £10,000 £835.16 School Disco £77 Art Competition £281.45 Cake Sale £9,000 Making a total of £4193.61 raised so far this year and £8,000 we have £3,564.57 towards the climbing frame £7,000 Thank you to everyone who has supported theses £6,000 events,. We still have the Tuckfield Tournament, £5.000 Summer Fair and Leavers Disco planned for this £4,000 academic year and would love for any members of the St Mary's community to come and join us to help £3,000 organise, have some fun and meet other parents £2.000 whilst raising important funds for the school.
