Definition

A 'looked after child' has the same meaning as in section 22(1) of the Children Act 1989 and means any child who is (a) in the care of a local authority or (b) being provided with accommodation by them in the exercise of their social services functions (e.g., children with foster parents) at the time of making application to the school.

A 'previously looked after child' is a child who was looked after but ceased to be so because he or she was adopted or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order including those who appear to the governing body to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted. Where appropriate, the school may request parents/carers to provide evidence to confirm that a child meets this definition.

Admissions Policy

Applicants are advised to read the school's admission policy that includes the oversubscription criteria that would be used if there are more applications than places available. The policy is available on the school website and from the school office.

Admissions Supplementary Form

If you or child is a regularly worships at a Christian Church both sections of this form must be sent directly to the School with this application form.
