Destination:	St Fagans National History Museum
Date of Trip:	Wednesday 1 st October 2025
Times:	We will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning at 3.15pm
Cost:	£11.00 This trip has been subsidised by the Friends of St Mary's
Details of trip:	This term the children will be finding out what homes are like in our community, whilst learning about how homes have changed through history. The children will look at how an aspect of life has changed over time for example doing the washing and sanitation. Visiting St Fagon's will provide children with the experience of visiting different homes spanning different ages, whilst taking part in a hands-on workshop "Washday with Beti Bwt"
