Attendance

We are currently receiving an increasing number of request for absence forms. We recognise spending quality time as a family is enriching but we ask that all holidays are booked during the 13 weeks school holidays when the school is closed.

We can not authorise any requests for absence for holidays. Any period of absence of more than 10 sessions/ 5 days in a 7 school week period may result in penalty notices being issued. The fine is currently £60 (per parent, per child) if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice rising to £120 if paid after 21 days but within 28 days. Further guidance can be found on the school website along with a copy of the request for absence form that MUST be completed before the absence, email's on the day of your child's absence are not acceptable.
