#### **Attendance**

This is a reminder that we can not authorise any requests for absence for holidays. Any period of absence of more than 10 sessions/ 5 days in a 7 school week period may result in penalty notices being issued. The fine is currently £60 (per parent, per child) if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice rising to £120 if paid after 21 days but within 28 days. Further guidance can be found on the school website along with a copy of the request for absence form that **MUST** be completed before the absence, email's on the day of your child's absence are not acceptable.
