Destination:	The New Rooms, Broadway, Bristol
Date of Trip:	Thursday 16 th November 2023
Times:	We will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning at 3pm
Cost:	£14.89
Details of trip:	We will be exploring the river and journeys that have taken place, in particular, the slave trade in Bristol. We would love to explore this further by taking a trip to the 'New Rooms' in Bristol. This building is the oldest Methodist building in the world built by John Wesley, someone we have been discussing closely in our RE lessons. We would love to take the opportunity to explore this historic building and learn more about Wesley's input in the abolition of the slave trade.
Lunch:	All children will require a packed lunch and bottle of water for the trip. Please can you ensure there are no nut products or chocolate bars in the lunch boxes.
Clothing:	All children will need to wear school uniform and will require a rain coat as we will need to walk from the coach through Cabot Circus to get to the New Rooms.
