School Drop off and Collection

In the guidance laid out by the government, schools have been asked to stagger start and end times. At St Mary's we have elected to arrange this using children's surnames as this enabled us to:

- Restrict the number of people on site
- Restrict the number of people gathered in one area at any one time e.g. by classroom door
- Enable parents to bring siblings to school at the same time
- Enable teacher to better manage handwashing.

We are all still finding our way but on the whole the system seems to be working effectively and is achieving our main goal of enabling families to be able to socially distance at drop off and collection times.

Whilst we put these controls in place, we are not able to manage peoples' behaviour and therefore we appeal to you to ensure that you are maintaining a 2m distance from one another at all times.

We will continue to monitor and make any necessary adjustments to the system.

KS1 Provision and exciting new environment

We have been fortunate to work alongside the school improvement partner Geraldine Tidy and are very excited to be using play based provision in key stage 1. For our Year 1 children, this will build on the children's previous experiences in the foundation stage and will support a smooth transition into Key Stage 1. This is particularly important this year in the current situation. For our Year 2 children, this will provide an opportunity to consolidate their prior learning and re-engage their thirst for learning. Children will have the opportunity to work both indoors and outdoors in small teacher guided groups, independently and as a whole class.



During the first 3 weeks of term, the children will have the opportunity to explore the different environments and adults will be spending a lot of time modelling expectations. We will be sharing lots of photos of the children's explorations on our school Dojo page for you to be able to follow the journey.
