PE DAYS

Whilst we have enjoyed having some flexibility around PE days during September, from **Monday 5th October** classes will have set PE days, class teachers will be in touch to confirm these days. On your child's PE days they will need to come into school dressed in their PE Kit.

The school PE kit consists of a plain white polo shirt, plain black shorts/jogging bottoms or leggings and trainers or daps.

As we enter the colder months children should wear their school jumper, cardigan or fleece over their kit.
